Dear Preschool Families,

I hope that you all had a wonderful spring break and that you had a chance to rest and relax with family and friends. It has been so nice to see our favorite little friends return to school this week!

Please be sure that you send your child with a coat or jacket appropriate for the weather of the moment! As we have seen these last few weeks, it can change on a dime but we do try to go out for recess whenever possible, so please try to be sure your kiddo is ready for those recess breaks.

April is the Month of the Military Child. We want to take this moment to recognize our military connected families and to thank you for your service. We know that your children serve, too and we thank you!

If your child will be returning to preschool with us next year, I will be reaching out to you with your placement as far as morning or afternoon within the next couple of weeks. I tried to keep your schedule the same unless you requested a change or if your child comes from the CDC and will turn 5 early in the year. I do my best to honor requests, but never guarantee a particular session because I know I won't always be able to meet those commitments. Sometimes, there are circumstances out of my control.

If you are concerned about the fact that Prop K was not passed by voters and how that might affect our program for the 24-25 school year, I can tell you that we will be fine. Our existing classrooms should be ok for the next few years. Prop K would have allowed us to expand to town and would have guaranteed the preschool opportunities we have now. From here on out, it will be a year to year decision depending upon the need for Kindergarten, 1st grade and Early Childhood Special Education classrooms. Again, for next year we'll be fine and there will be room for everyone returning to one of our programs.

This year our 4's program will be going on a field trip to Twisters in Warrensburg. Our 3's program will be taking a field trip to the park across the street from Whiteman Elementary. The 4s trips have been arranged and the details on the trip to the park will be announced closer to that date. Both trips will require a permission slip and no child will be allowed to participate without a signed note.

Just a reminder, if your child is going to kindergarten next year, we will provide the screening for both elementary buildings. We will share the same result paper that they would get if you had scheduled an appointment. No need to schedule a screening.
